Exercise 1 – The Square

Shooting area defined as the ground surrounding a 5-metre square of barriers at waist height. Start at any corner with the gun fully-loaded (Option1), two hands on the gun, but touching the waist. No further re-loads. Shooting over the barriers allowed.

On the start signal, run to the next adjacent corner and engage any of the 5 plates located at 10 metres in front of the square with one shot. Run to the next adjacent corner and fire one shot. Run to the next corner and shoot one shot. If any shot misses, move to the next corner before taking a subsequent shot. Repeat until all plates fall. The average of three attempts to count as the score.

Exercise 2 – Apertures Right and Left

Shooting area defined as the ground behind two apertures left and right at waist height. Start with the gun fully-loaded (Option1), two hands on the gun, butt touching the waist, muzzle centred between the apertures No further re-loads.

On the start signal, engage through either aperture, one of any of the 5 plates located at 10 metres to the left of the aperture and one of the 5 plates to the right. Each plate must fall before moving to the next plate or aperture. Move to the other aperture and repeat (one plate from the left group and one from the right).

The exercise is complete when four plates have fallen or the gun is empty. Average of three to count.

Exercise 3 – Running and Gunning

Shooting area defined as the ground adjacent to barriers at waist height extending over a distance of approximately 15 metres towards 5 plates positioned 8 metres beyond the furthest barrier. The barriers so positioned as to require the shooter to move forwards 5 metres, then to the side 5 metres, then forward 5 metres to a final charge-line barrier.

Start with the gun fully-loaded (Option1) at the rearmost point of the barriers, two hands on the gun, butt touching the waist, No further re-loads. Shooting over the barriers is allowed.

On the start signal, engage any of the 5 plates **while moving continuously**. Any shot fired whilst stationary or pausing in movement incurs a penalty of 5 seconds to the shooter's time. The exercise is complete when all five plates have fallen or the gun is empty. Plates left standing incur a penalty of 10 seconds. Average of three to count.

In the table below P= Penalty shot taken whilst paused/stationary (5 secs/shot), M= Plates left standing (10 secs/plate)
